### **HMP Ford:**

We need to find another willing member to be vetted to provide extra cover for the Saturday meeting if possible. (The meetings are well attended and attracting new members). Mark K now has access to attend and facilitate meetings at HMP Ford. Having been granted Standard Plus authorisation.

Things are changing soon at Ford. DART will soon be opening during the evenings. Making it more likely to hold a second NA meeting in Ford early evening.

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### **HMP Lewes:**

Paul R and I have attended HMP Lewes on most occasions so far since starting the NA meeting on M wing. Also taking part in the "Stepping Stones" process too. As agreed last month: Paul & I visited the Forward Trust office and had a lengthy discussion about the way forward. Between us all, an outline was agreed. Hold the meeting during "free flow" in the Group room. Tuesday midday-ish. Up to 4 NA members able to attend (2 vetted and 2 NA guests). This would open up the attendance to inmates from several different "Wings". However, we will have to have some further training, then carry radios. The earliest that the radio training will be? Towards the end of November or early December. After some discussion, the committee agreed to allow Paul R and Steve L to continue working with Forward Trust to achieve the desired outcomes. I.e. Group room possibility 2-hour slot on Free flow.....
