Programming Report

Sticking to the structure used last year as it worked really well. Main hall will have 8 speakers on the Saturday and 6 speakers on the Sunday. One upstairs room will be a marathon meeting but it will be more organised this year and the other upstairs room will be the Holistic room. Have 8 speakers confirmed for the weekend so far. The UKNA Convention has been a bit of a sticking point in getting speakers as they are holding it the weekend after ours.

Have received invoice from the venue and will send to EJ SANAC 14 Treasurer to pay when due.

Flyers are printed and were given out to all committee members and visitors for distribution to meetings across Sussex and further afield.

Flyer is up on the Sussex NA website but not on the UKNA website, EJ has chased this up with webservant and is waiting to hear back.

Invoice for flyers printing was £78.00 has been reimbursed from SANAC account and will send invoice to EJ SANAC 14 Treasurer.
