Website traffic is increasing all the time and is proving to be a valuable asset to our area, both for members and non-members. Stats for November (1<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>) 1235 unique visitors, current average is over 41 visits per day, November saw a big increase, mainly due to updates on the meetings page.

**Ongoing work:** We have been working on the new meetings page, this still has a few teething problems, i.e the search option is still missing. This should be resolved asap. In the meantime, please keep checking the site for your meeting and inform us asap of any changes required. We have updated the site with the festive period meeting closures and also the upcoming F&E events.
