- A. x2 special workers @ £40 pw. Paid by the ASC, employed as special workers on a 3-month review.
- Q. Why 2 special workers?
- A. To protect the children and to protect each special worker. Also due to safeguarding. Different policies from the council, depends on how many hours worked.

## **East & Central Lancashire**

- Q. Can UK RSC pay RCM expenses
- A. £127.00 RCM expenses approved.
- Q. Any Chitty experience around prisons requesting attendance information on incarcerated member?
- A. We are under no surveillance at any time. We do not report back to prisons.
- Q. CAR report to complex
- A. This is a simplified version. RD and Alt RD are willing to travel & help deliver CAR workshops.
- Q. One group feels the 6<sup>th</sup> tradition is being breached as a member clicked on a link on the website and was lead to Apple advertisements

## Subcommittee Reports

#### UK H& I

Please can RCMs get all their H&I meetings on their reports?

"FLO" stands for Fellowship Liaison Officer

Q: SE London - Do you communicate and what's your solution?

A: Strong communications but not in all areas. Let us know what is not working and we can try to fix that.

Q: Hampshire – How do we get a refund if we send a rep to your meeting?

A: We need some clarity around that and the guidelines need updating.

SW London – Be aware that H&I are shutting down. Things are moving fast.

Treasurer – Current UK H&I Guidelines say nothing about refunding people's per diem who put themselves forward. These guidelines would need to be updated to reflect this if this is changed. Remember, Regional guidelines take precedence.

Q: East Coast Scotland – Is Liverpool separate from Merseyside?

A: Apologies, this was a typo.

Treasurer – For UK H&I Financial Report, please see March working documents.

#### **UK Comms**

Q: NE England – 12 Step Call List – a number had been given out directly to a male member. Surely this is not allowed?

A: We have a policy not to give out numbers. Please call UK Comms ASAP if this happens again.

UK H&I – We can work with you regarding our excess female sponsors for your female sponsees.

# **Treasurer Report**

#### **Balances**

Prudent Reserve £12,300.00

Opening Balance £20,118.18

Contributions £9,863.45 Expenses (£9,721.06)

Closing Balance £17,080.35

Treasurer: Regarding Public Liability insurance, we are still awaiting a reply. The new quote came in at £6,000. The old quote was £2,935 – this includes all of the UK, but not events.

Treasurer: UK H&I has £2,458.70 in its bank account. Because Region is paying for UK H&I at the moment, could this balance be returned to the UK RSC bank account?

UK H&I: That makes perfect sense. We have no objections.

Treasurer: UK RSC audit – this will be done with the assistance of the UKSO Director, who is also an accountant. They are happy to do this on a just expenses basis.

Treasurer: Cornwall RCM handed in her commitment and we were room sharing in May. I am now stuck with the costs. Please can I claim back £60? PASSED.

Treasurer: Subcommittees, can you please produce your yearly budgeting and can you send these through to me?

Treasurer: Vice Treasurer is now on the Regional bank account. I will remove the previous Chair and add our new Chair.

Treasurer: Given that we don't know what the future funding will be like with this COVID-19, I recommend suspending payments to all the subcommittees except frontline, which is UK Comms and Prison Sponsorship. PASSED.

Treasurer: I recommend suspending any payments to EDM and World until we know what our current financial status will be as we go through COVID-19. PASSED.
