

This survey was open to NA members from 1st April 2020 to 31st August 2020.


1918 responded to the survey.



England 1108 [86%], Scotland 122 [9%], Northern Ireland 34 [3%], Wales 24 [2%], Channel Islands 4.






Question: What is your employment status?








Simple Count of Qualifications since coming to NA




Number of Qualifications



















